When combined with the closing of the U.S. Department of Education and other U.S. policy changes, this creates various challenges for education at all levels, from K-12 through higher education. These policy transformations and budgetary constraints are impacting various facets of the education landscape, necessitating adjustments in curriculum adoption, grant funding strategies and the delivery of student services. Both K-12 and higher education institutions are navigating changes in federal oversight, funding and regulatory reviews.

Though specific ramifications are not yet clear, education organizations are now reviewing short-term impacts and longer-term scenarios. The recent policy changes on education will affect:

- Delivery of federal aid to students, institutions and loan management
- K-12 funding for education of students with disabilities and those from low-income families
- Collection and publication of data regarding education achievement, enrollment and program completions


