What is an “emerging risk?”

Emerging risks are those that haven’t significantly affected the enterprise yet but could have major impacts in the future. Their developments can be unpredictable and rapid.

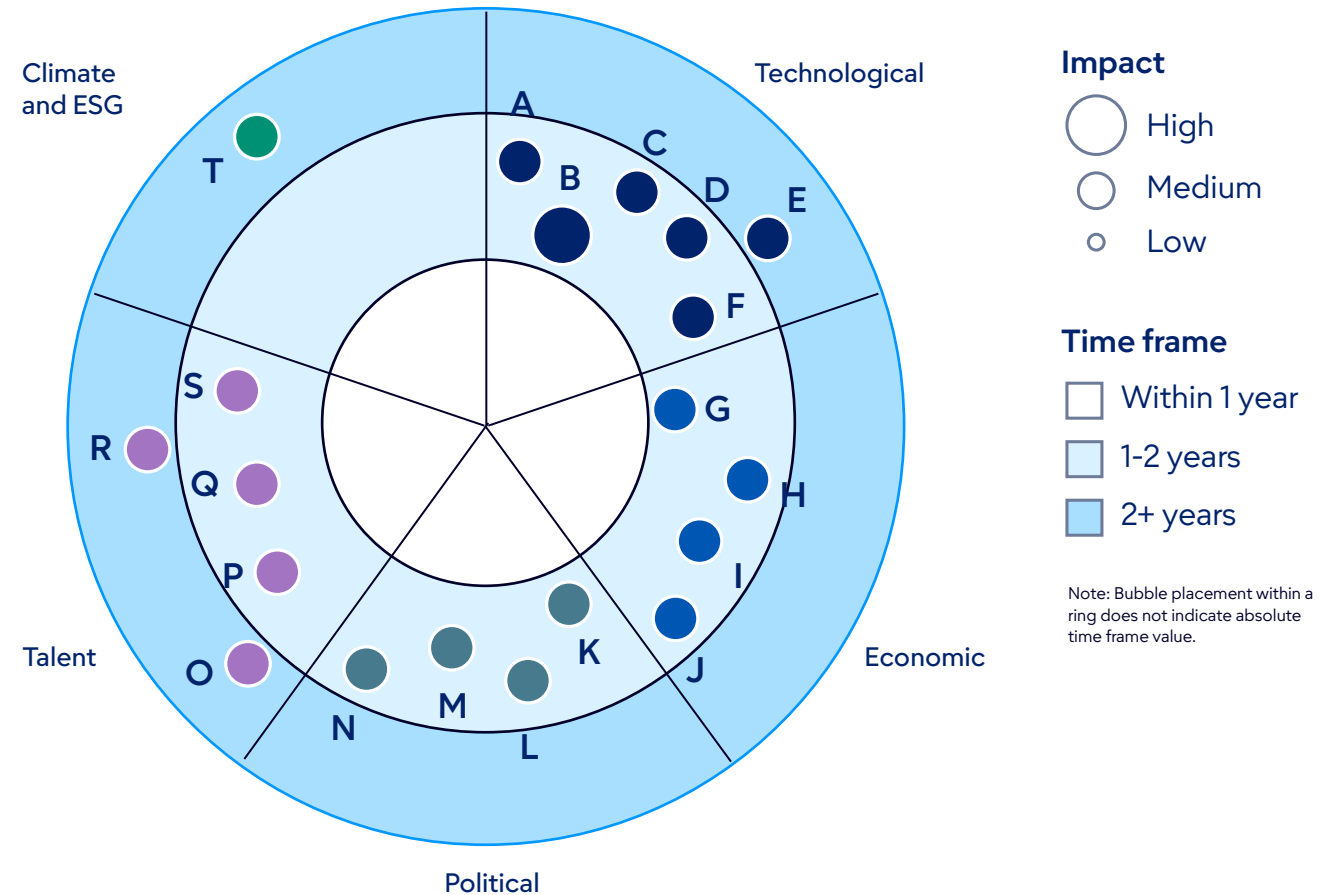

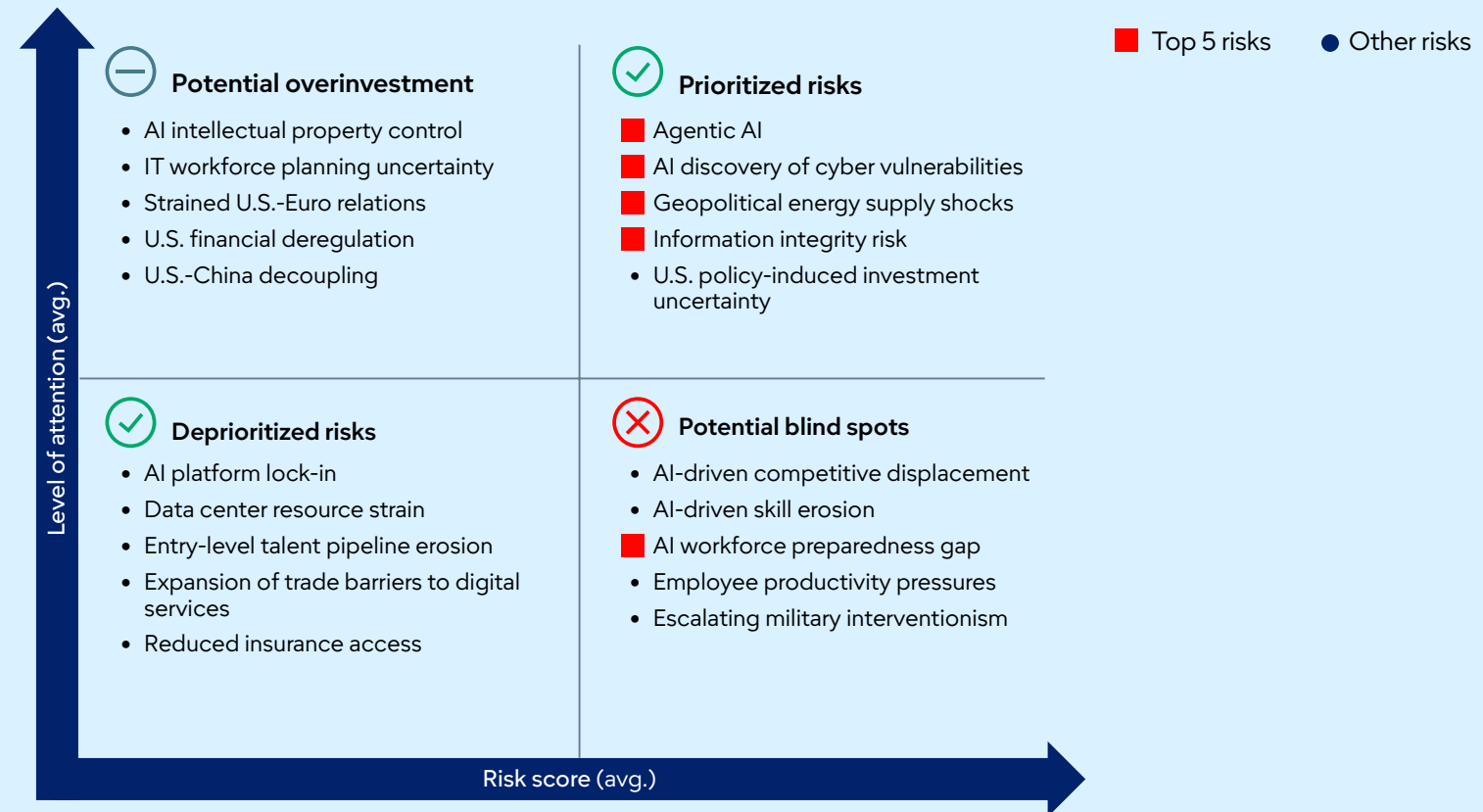

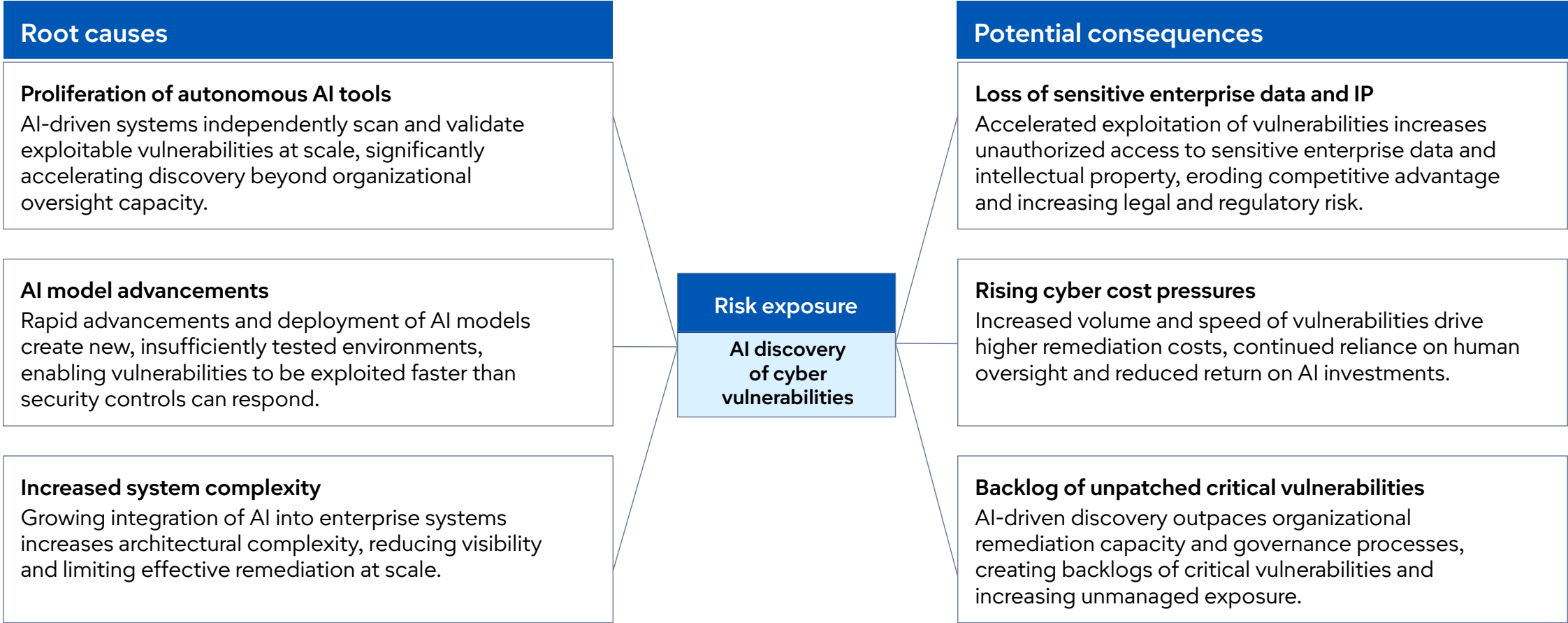
Emerging risks by level of attention and risk score

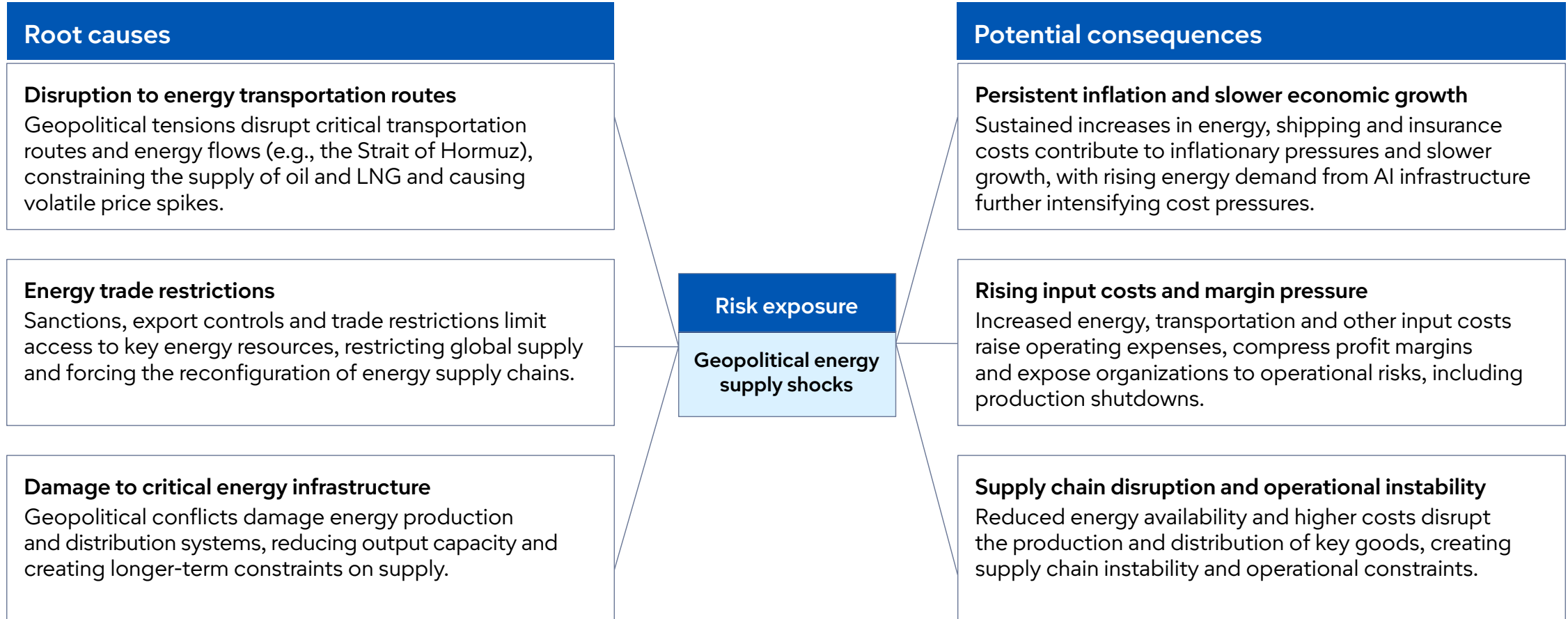
AI discovery of cyber vulnerabilities

Risk description: The risk that rapid advances in AI accelerate the discovery and exploitation of previously unknown cyber vulnerabilities, outpacing organizational defenses, leading to cascading cyber incidents and operational disruptions.



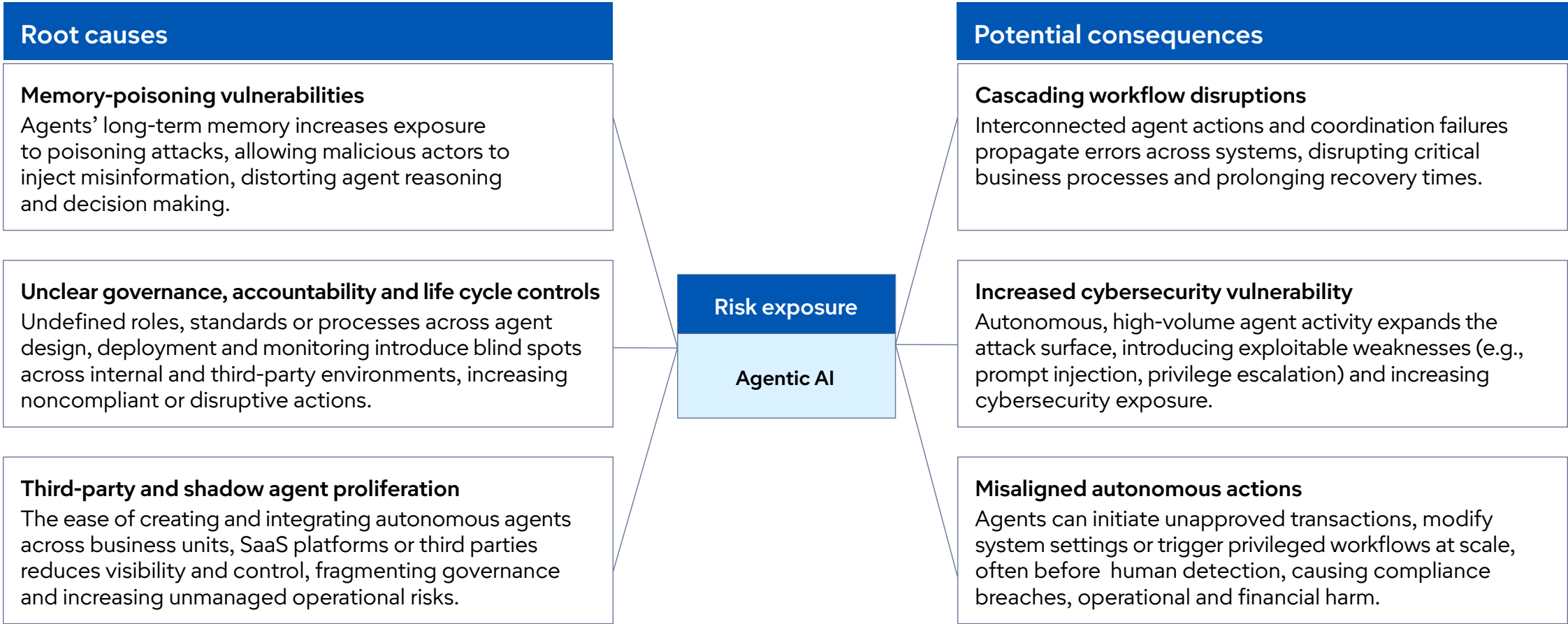
Geopolitical energy supply shocks

Risk description: The risk that **geopolitical conflicts, sanctions and infrastructure disruption generate recurring energy supply shocks** across production, distribution and logistics that increase price volatility, complicate planning and amplify broader macroeconomic instability.



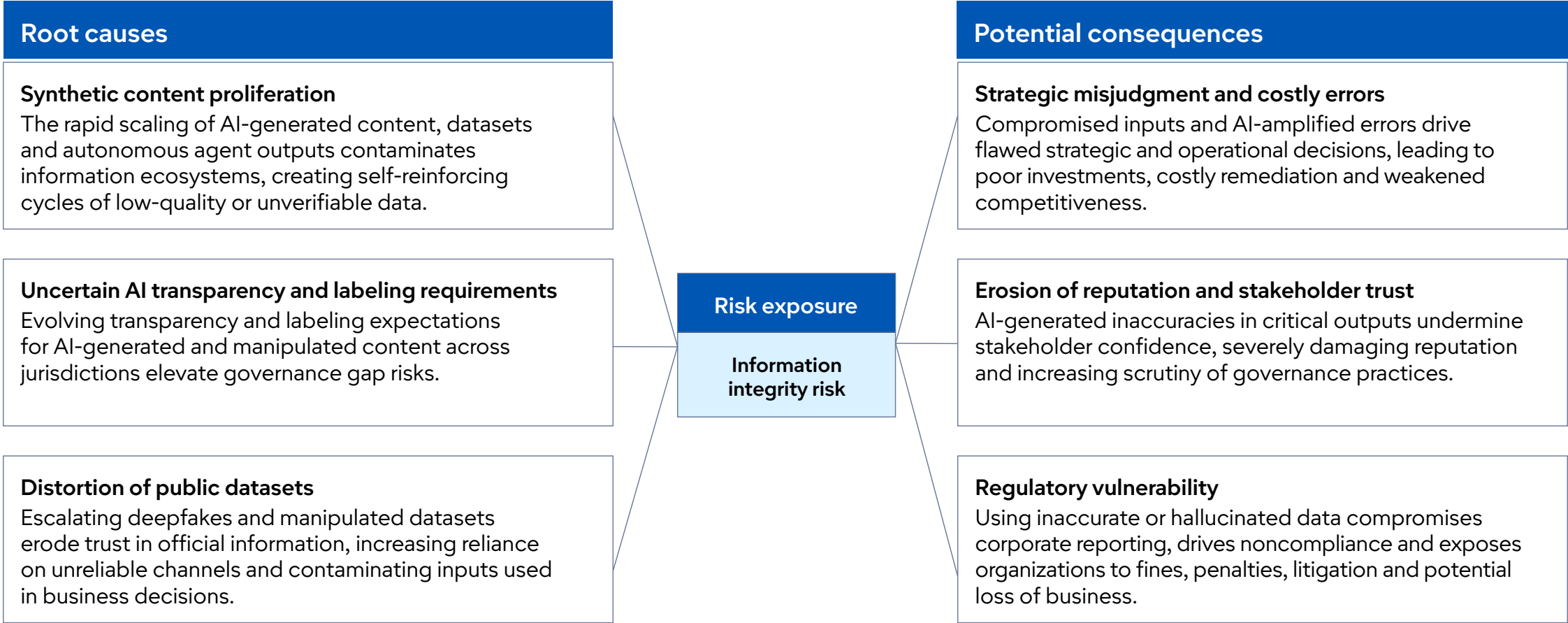
Agentic AI

Risk description: The risk that agentic AI could **make decisions and take actions not aligned with organizational policies, goals, ethical principles or legal requirements**, leading to operational disruptions, compliance challenges and reputational harm.



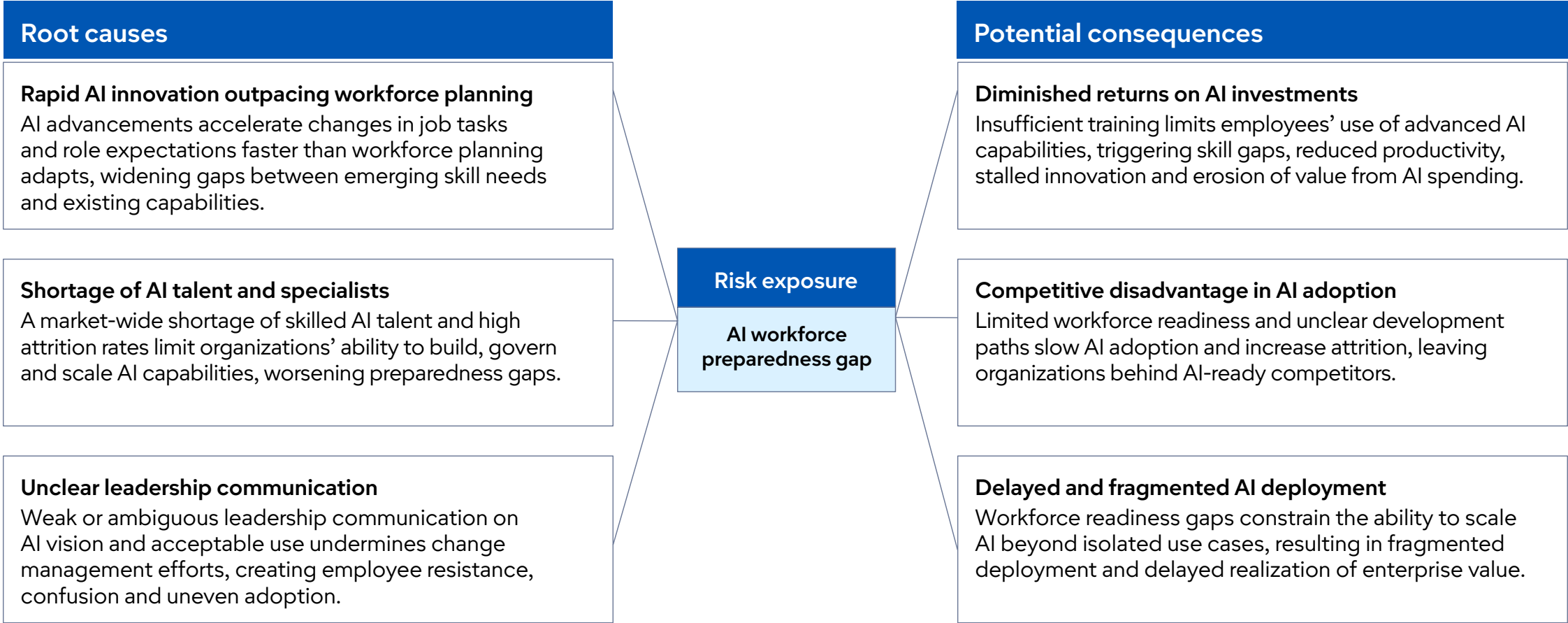
Information integrity risk

Risk description: The risk that the **proliferation of unreliable and low-quality public datasets, AI-generated content and politicization of data reduces access to accurate information**, leading to costly decisions and misinformed strategies.



AI workforce preparedness gap

Risk description: The risk that rapid adoption of **AI-enabled roles outpaces organizations’ ability to build employee proficiency** by defining effective training approaches, establishing clear learning pathways and developing role-appropriate capabilities, resulting in persistent skills gaps and diminished returns on AI investments.

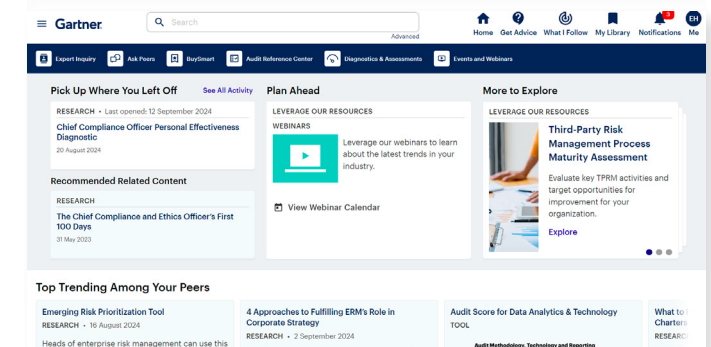
